During Lent we are inviting persons to "lighten up" or "let go" of the stuff that may hamper our relationship with Christ. Sometimes it is necessary to relinquish what is holding us back, for only in doing so can we give our very best.

It's what we want to focus on in Lent: Letting go so we can truly give our very best. It's what Mary does with the expensive perfume in John's Gospel when she takes a pound of costly perfume made of pure nard and pours it on Jesus' feet. The act startles the disciples, especially Judas, who says that the money for the perfume could have been used to help the poor. Jesus, however, accepts Mary's gift and reminds Judas that nothing is ever wasted.

Jesus' actions toward Mary raise all kinds of questions, but one of the questions is "Are we giving God are best?" There are times when we may ask if what we are doing is wasting our time or money on something. We may wonder if we have wasted something precious. Maybe we could have given to something or someone else. It's a fair question. After all, resources are tight.

But Mary's action toward Jesus is an action worth considering as he makes his way toward the cross: are we doing what we can to give Jesus our best? Are we walking in a way that leads to true compassion and generosity, or are we walking in ways that may withhold our true gifts? Are we letting go, or hanging on? This is a season to answer that question in spirit and in truth.

All God's Children Preschool registration is under way for 2010-2011! Enroll as soon as possible, classes fill up quickly on a first-come basis. Families in Grace Church and those currently enrolled have first opportunity to register, but open-enrollment, for anyone, begins February 28th. Submit enrollment forms and \$75 registration fee to guarantee a spot! Our classes & fees are as follows: (*Children must be the age of class enrolling-in by August 1st*)

2's classes – Mon. & Weds. OR Tues. & Thurs., 8:00-11:00 \$90/month
(max 8 children to 2 teachers)

3's classes – Mon. & Weds. OR Tues. & Thurs., 8:00-11:00 \$90/month
(max 13 children to 2 teachers)

Pre-K(4/5's) classes – Tues., Weds., & Thurs., 8:00-11:00 \$115/month
(max 12 children to 1 teacher & one "floater" assistant between the 2 classes)

Bonus Friday – An extra day for ages 2-5 already enrolled in preschool, 8:00-11:00, \$30/month

Parents' Day Out – Fridays, 8-11, for 6 months-5 years for tots too young for preschool, or older preschool-age kids not enrolled in our regular preschool program (3 hours of "freedom" for parents!) Cost: \$60/month, ages 6 mos-2 yrs; \$45/month 2-5 years.

*We offer sibling discounts of \$10 per month for regular preschool, and \$5/month for P.D.O., and registration discounts for 2nd & 3rd child. Tuition paid in advance for the entire school year will be discounted by an amount equal to 1 month's tuition.

We are sad to say goodbye to our preschool assistant teacher and nursery helper, Kalin Roberts, as she begins her journey and adventure to life in Alaska. Kalin is moving to Anchorage where she and her husband, Patrick, will live as he serves the US Air Force. Good luck and prayers to both.

A NOTE FROM PASTOR JENOTHY

Have you ever wondered who the most important face of a church is? Or, what is the most important space of a church? Your answers may vary according to age, experience, and level of involvement. However, one would be hard pressed to argue that it is anyone but the children, and it is anywhere but the children’s wing that is the most important space of a healthy and growing church!

Why? According to Rita B. Hays, pastor and educator, “Our journey of faith begins at birth. The care that children receive in your church nursery will have an impact on their faith formation throughout their lives.” The key to understanding this idea is to recognize that we are ALL children of God; whether chronologically young, old, or somewhere in between. We are God’s children and we are all “hungry and needing to be fed like our nursery children.”

There may be rain and snow outside right now, but spring will come, and as I reflect on the life that waits to burst forth, I think too about the “new lives” we are building in our nursery and children’s wing here at Grace Church. I think about being a child of God myself, and as a “child” what am I hungry for? What am I “eating”? What do I thirst for? How am I being spiritually fed and in turn, what am I “feeding” others?

Hays goes on to say, “God reaches out to our children the moment they are born, extending grace and love. When your nursery room is filled with grace upon grace, infants and their parents cannot help but feel welcomed by you and by a loving God. When your church extends grace upon grace to every child you have been blessed to nurture in the faith, visitors cannot help but be captured by God’s grace and your gracious hospitality.”

I can hardly wait to see what God will bring forth from our nursery and how God’s “children” will make a difference!
