Ministries in Indiana Conference **\$116,167**

Music and Worship Ministries **\$93,835**

Youth and Children's Ministries **\$119,597**

Pastoral Ministry **\$233,642**

Administration Ministries **\$166,622**

Facilities and Grounds **\$146,524**
