

Grace Church and Higher Education Ministries and Connections

Franklin Grace Church finds ways to partner with institutions of higher education and campus ministry. It is fortunate to connect in ministry with the following:

Asbury Theological Seminary – At times, the pastors of Grace Church have mentored seminary students from Asbury Theological Seminary. Several persons have explored the pathway into the ministry. Several youth from Grace Church have attended Asbury University.

United Theological Seminary – Grace Church has a unique relationship with United Theological Seminary. The Reverends Bob Coleman and Andy Kinsey have served on the Board of Trustees of United Theological Seminary. Grace Church supports and has funded the Bob Coleman Scholarship to a seminary student at UTS who is planning to serve in the Indiana Conference. In addition, Grace Church has hosted a number of faculty and guest speakers: Jason Vickers, Wendy Deichmann, David Watson, Kent Millard, and Peter Bellini.

University of Indianapolis – Grace Church also seeks to foster ongoing relationships with the University of Indianapolis, through Youth Internships and teaching opportunities. Support also takes the shape of providing the University Choir singing opportunities as well as via the Lantz Center for Christian Vocations. Several professors have taught courses at Grace Church as well: Jeremiah Gibbs and Michael Cartwright. Other collaborative efforts have occurred as well.

Franklin College – Grace Church cooperates with ministries and faculty at Franklin College, via music and religion. Pastors at Grace Church have taught courses at Franklin College, as well as share in ministry and service opportunities through sororities, fraternities, and Intervarsity Fellowship.
